PASTORAL DIRECTION

To The Rev. Martha Ann Englert:

I, the Rt. Rev. Steven A. Miller, Bishop of the Diocese of Milwaukee, in my capacity as pastor, teacher and canonical overseer of the Rev. Martha Ann Englert, hereby give the following Pastoral Direction to the Rev. Englert as a solemn warning to her. A Presentment dated April 29, 2006 has been issued against the Rev. Englert by the Standing Committee of this Diocese acting as the Diocesan Review Committee, and I have issued an Inhibition dated April 29, 2006, as modified May 10, 2006, to you under Title IV, Canon 1, Section 3 of the Canons of the Episcopal Church (the "Inhibition"). The reasons for this Pastoral Direction is to provide guidance and direction to the Rev. Englert as that proceeding commences, and to ensure that all who participate in the investigation may be able to do so freely and without having to experience or fear coercion, intimidation, repercussions or retaliation, and that the life of the parish at Grace Church continue without undue disruption under the circumstances.

Because of these concerns, I hereby issue the following Pastoral Direction and Godly Admonition to the Rev. Martha Ann Englert.

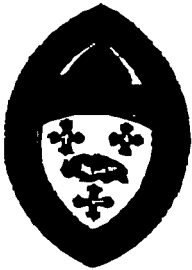
1. You shall not, directly or indirectly, attempt to influence or coerce any person with respect to information such person may have provided to the investigation of the Church Attorney or any testimony such person may provide to the Ecclesiastical Trial Court.
2. If any person does not wish to talk with you or receive communications from you, you will respect such person's wishes and restrict your communications with such person through legal process.

A Pastoral Direction is recognized by the Canons of the Church as being mandatory and binding. Ordination vows of a Priest promise obedience to the pastoral direction of the Bishop. Disobedience of a Pastoral Direction may be grounds for charges under Title IV of the National Canons.

This Pastoral Direction replaces the Pastoral Direction dated February 11, 2006, and is issued as a solemn warning effective May 10, 2006.

INHIBITION

A Presentment dated April 29, 2006 has been made against the Rev. Martha Englert by the Standing Committee of the Diocese of Milwaukee acting in its capacity as Diocesan Review Committee. Pursuant to Title IV, Canon 1, Section 3 of the Canons of the Episcopal Church, I hereby inhibit the Rev. Martha Englert from exercising the gifts of ordination in the ordained ministry as follows:

1. She shall not appear in public wearing a clerical collar, other clerical dress or other outward identification of herself as a priest of this Church, except in canonical proceedings before the Ecclesiastical Trial Court, and shall not hold herself out as a priest of this Church.
2. She shall not perform any priestly ministrations.
3. She shall not publicly preach.
4. She shall return all property of Grace Episcopal Church, Madison (the "Parish") now in her possession, she shall remove her personal property from the Parish property, and she shall surrender to the Wardens of the Parish all keys to Parish facilities.
5. She shall not attend Parish meetings, participate in any decision-making about the business or worship of Parish, exercise any authority conferred to the Rector under Title III, Canon 14 of the Canons of the Episcopal Church, or otherwise function as the Rector of the Parish.

This Inhibition, as revised effective May 10, 2006, will remain in effect for until after the Judgment of the Ecclesiastical Trial Court becomes final. This Inhibition is effective immediately.
